In the field of civil justice, pending procedures and proceedings initiated

before the end of the transition period will continue under EU law. The e-Justice Portal, on the basis of a mutual agreement with the UK, will maintain

the relevant information related to the United Kingdom until the end of 2024.

England and Wales
