- in Slovakia: Articles 37 to 37e of Act No 97/1963 on Private International Law and the Rules of Procedure relating thereto.

Annex II - The courts or competent authorities to which the application referred to in Article 39 may be submitted

district court (*okresný súd*), Bratislava III Municipal Court (*Mestský súd Bratislava III*), Bratislava IV Municipal Court (*Mestský súd Bratislava IV*) and Košice Municipal Court (*Mestský súd Košice*)

Annex III - The courts with which appeals referred to in Article 43(2) may be lodged

district courts (*okresné súdy*) and municipal courts (*mestské súdy*)

Annex IV- The appeals which may be lodged pursuant to Article 44

- in Slovakia, the *dovolenie*.

Appellate review (*dovolenie*) before the Supreme Court of the Slovak Republic (*Najvyšší súd Slovenskej republiky*). Applications for appellate review must be lodged through the district court whose decision is being appealed against.

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
